National Pollution Prevention Day, 2020

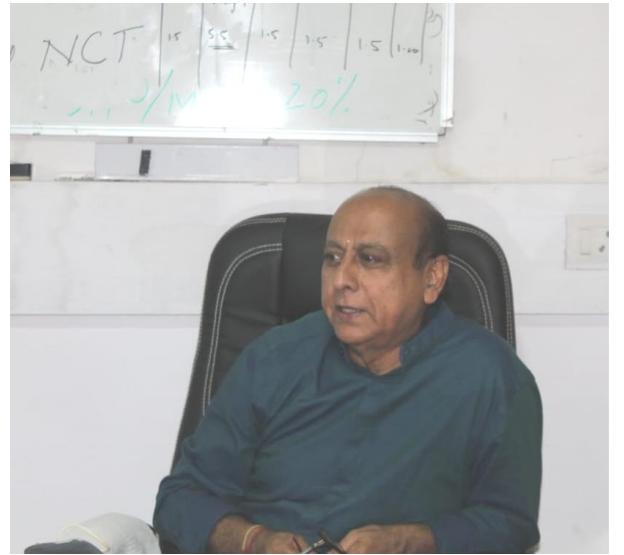
The National Pollution Prevention Day is observed every year on 2nd December in the remembrance of those who lost their lives in the Bhopal Gas Tragedy, 1984 on the night of 2-3 December.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Bharat Jain, Member Secretary, GCPC and Coordinator, GCPC-ENVIS addressed the team member briefing about the significance of National Pollution Prevention Day.

He mentioned, as per the official records of the government of Madhya Pradesh at total of 3,788 people were killed in the gas release and 5,74,366 injured victims sustained injuries.

Dr. Jain briefed the history behind constituting Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) saying that CPCB was constituted in September, 1974 ten years before the Bhopal disaster to work towards the protection of the environment. In the ten years that followed, the government launched more acts and rules to control pollution in the country.

The discussion concluded, taking pledge by GCPC team members under the leadership of Dr. Bharat Jain, Member Secretary, GCPC & Coordinator, ENVIS on creating more and more mass awareness about the concept of pollution prevention, resource efficiency and cleaner production to avoid such tragedy's in the future and create a better tomorrow for future generations.
