GCPC-ENVIS Centre organized Cleaner Production Promotion Programme in household at Vidya Bharti Training Sankool, Gandhinagar on 08th January, 2020. More than 25 primary and secondary school teachers from Vidya Bharti Training Sankool have participated in programme.

The inaugural session started with 'Saraswati Vandana' by GCPC-ENVIS team members and the participants.

Ms. Priyanka Joshi, Information Officer, GCPC-ENVIS welcomed the participants and addressed the gathering. Ms. Priyanka Joshi explained that how Cleaner Production plays a crucial role for domestic waste management and also Highlighted Gujarat industrial growth and activities of GCPC. She mentioned that Gujarat being the fastest developing state in terms of economy and industrial growth that also results into various types of pollution badly affected on environment as well as on human health.

She Continued Session with stressed upon the Scenario of Food Waste and options for reducing food waste during day-to-day activities. She gave simple steps to reduce food waste including steps for food waste reuse, recycling and composting as natural manure. She continued discussing about the Global Scenario of Electronic and Plastic Waste generation and health hazards associated with excessive usage of Electronic Appliances especially from mobile phones and precautions for the same.
