Gujarat Cleaner Production Centre – ENVIS Centre had organized a programme on Cleaner Production in Household at GCPC Seminar Hall, Gandhinagar. The objective of the program was to spread awareness about wastage at domestic level and how we can implement the tools of cleaner production at household level to reduce the generation of waste at source.

More than 20 women from Gandhinagar, Ahmadabad and surroundings participated in the programme.

The programme started with Saraswati vandana.

Shri Punamchandra Rathod, Programme officer, GCPC-ENVIS welcomed the participants and addressed the gathering. Shri Rathod explained that how Cleaner Production plays a crucial role for domestic waste management and also Highlighted Gujarat industrial growth and activities of GCPC. He mentioned that Gujarat being the fastest developing state in terms of economy and industrial growth that also results into various types of pollution badly affected on environment as well as on human health.

He also said that, so far, many steps have been taken to reduce the hazardous waste generation, but it is better to prevent the pollution, rather than cure. He mentioned that the best way to reduce the pollution is to generate less waste.

Shri Paras Gojiya, Assistant Project Engineer, GCPC explained the existing water scarcity in the world and drinking water scenario in India. He showed different type of water losses in house and also discussed water conservation measures.

Next, Shri Kiran Varma, Assistant Project Engineer GCPC explained different type of Energy Losses at domestic level and also highlighted the energy conservation

measures. He also briefed advantages of solar energy over conventional energy resources.

Ms. Priyanka Joshi, Information Officer, GCPC-ENVIS explained the scenario of food waste management followed by plastic waste management and also highlighted the hazards associated with usages of mobile and its precautionary measures of mobile hazards. She also briefed different case studies for food waste management.

The final part of the programme was an open discussion for all the participants, in which many participants asked questions/queries related to various aspects of domestic waste management. Participant discussed existing problem of domestic waste in Gandhinagar and requested GCPC-ENVIS to arrange more Programme to aware the local people for waste management.

Participants thanked GCPC-ENVIS to arrange this kind of programme on household for women. They have also requested to arrange this kind of programme in schools, residential colonies, NGOs, hospitals, hotels etc.
